Rules & Event Disclaimer / Terms and Conditions

Start/Finish

Registration: Walkers from 07:00 to 08:00 with flexible start times

Runners from 08:00 to 09:00 flexible start times All to finish by 18.30

From Brush Bowls & Sports Club, Nanpantan Road Sports Ground,

Time Limit Based on 2.5-mile per hour Total time scale 11.5 hours.

Checkpoint 3 will close at 16.00 hours. Entrants arriving after this time will be retired. Long route entrants must arrive at Checkpoint 2 the cut-off point (12.4 miles) by 13.00 hours. Anyone arriving after 13.00 hours will automatically be diverted to the short route. Short route entrants arriving after this time will be retired. All entrants to finish by 18.30

Safety

All entrants must follow the route description checking in at all checkpoints. All retirees must inform an event official if need to retire. Event marshals are authorised to shorten route or retire anyone failing to comply with the event rules or who in their opinion is unfit to continue or unable to complete within the set time limit. The food provided at checkpoints cannot be guaranteed free from allergens.

First Aid and Emergencies

For any first aid or other emergencies experienced while at the HQ, please inform a marshal. As sections of the route are rural, rough underfoot, and remote from the road, in the event of an accident or a competitor becoming unwell please stop to provide assistance if necessary, and ensure that a marshal located at one of the check points are informed of the situation as soon as possible. In the unfortunate situation that you are unable to finish the event and need to retire, please make your way to the nearest check point or road, we also ask that you report to the finish before you leave the event.

Equipment

To include: - Clothing and Footwear appropriate to the event, waterproofs, compass, whistle, Torch, Basic First Aid kit, mug and one of the following maps: 1:50000 OS129 Nottingham & Loughborough Melton Mowbray or 1:25000 The National Forest OS Explorer 245 & Loughborough Melton Mowbray & Syston OS Explorer 246

Please bring your own copy of the route description. Electronic versions of route and maps are allowed.

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Entries

16–17-year-olds are welcome but must be accompanied by a responsible adult/ legal guardian who is 18 years or older for the duration of the event.

Overall event limit of 300.

You can cancel your entry with a refund minus a £2.00 administration charge - available until Saturday 28th February 2026. After that time the option to cancel / refund will no longer be available.

INSURANCE

Please note that non-LDWA members are not covered by the LDWA Insurance, but for £18.00 annually (DD) you could join the LDWA and would be covered by the LDWA insurance

Dogs

Well behaved dogs are welcome but must be covered by public liability insurance and kept on a lead and under close control by the owner at all times.

Country Code

I agree to abide by the rules of the event and to observe the Country Code at all times, and close of all gates unless left open by land owners

Event Disclaimer / Terms and Conditions

I have sufficient knowledge, experience, equipment and navigational skills to take part in a long distance event in all conditions.

I confirm that I am in good health and have no medical condition that may cause undue concern or inconvenience to others.

I confirm that I participate at my own risk and that no liability is accepted by the organisers for injury, damage or loss sustained by me before, during or after the event.

I confirm if under 18 I shall be accompanied by a responsible adult who is 18 years or older for the duration of the event and also have my own insurance either through the LDWA or by another organisation

I confirm that if I walk with a dog, it will be covered by public liability insurance and kept on a lead and under close control by at all times.



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I understand that the personal information submitted as part of this entry form will be held by the event organisers for a period of up to three years after the event is held for the purposes of managing this event only.

I further understand that photographs are likely to be taken at the event, which may be featured on the Brush Bowls web site or in the LDWA Strider magazine media.

In addition, I understand that Summary Information may be published immediately and may be held in perpetuity for the purposes of providing a record of the event.

I will have the right to request that all my personal Summary Information is anonymised.
